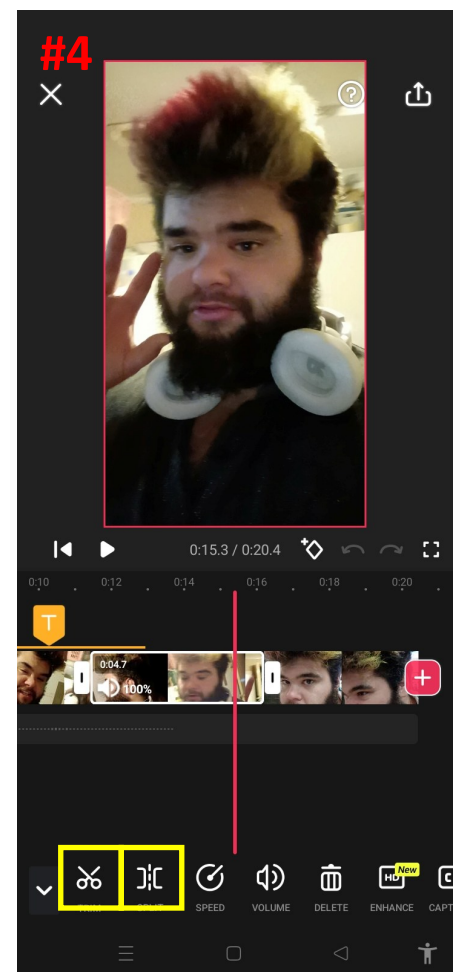
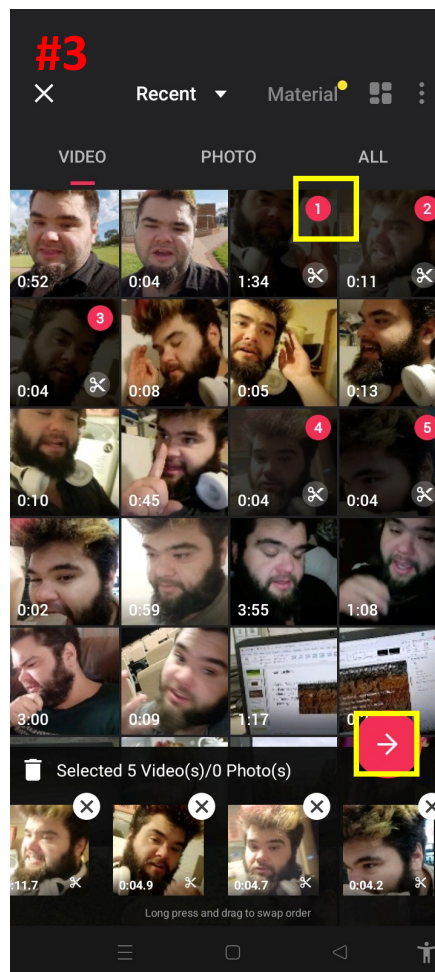
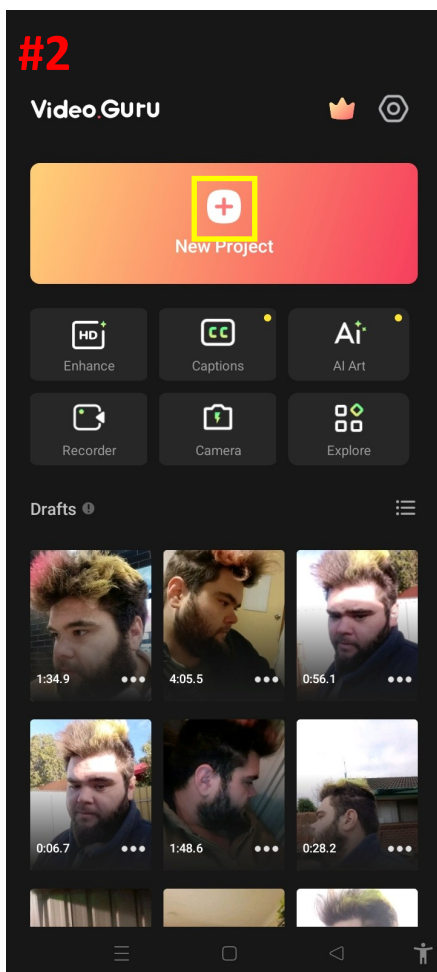
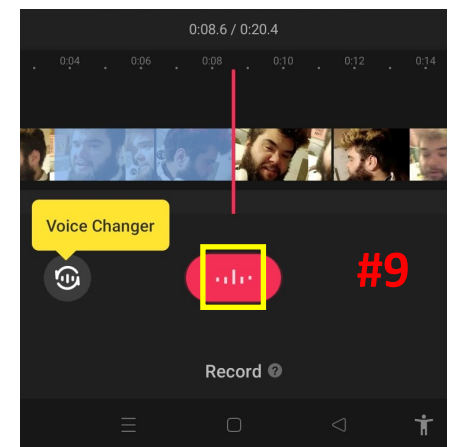
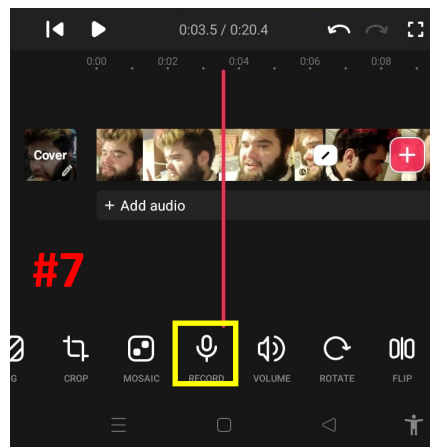
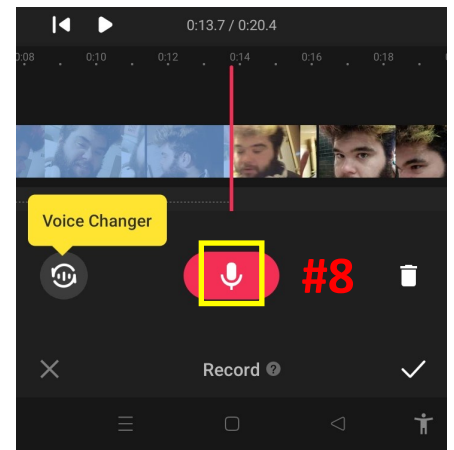
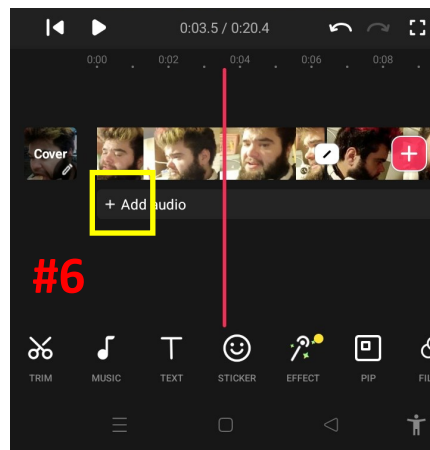
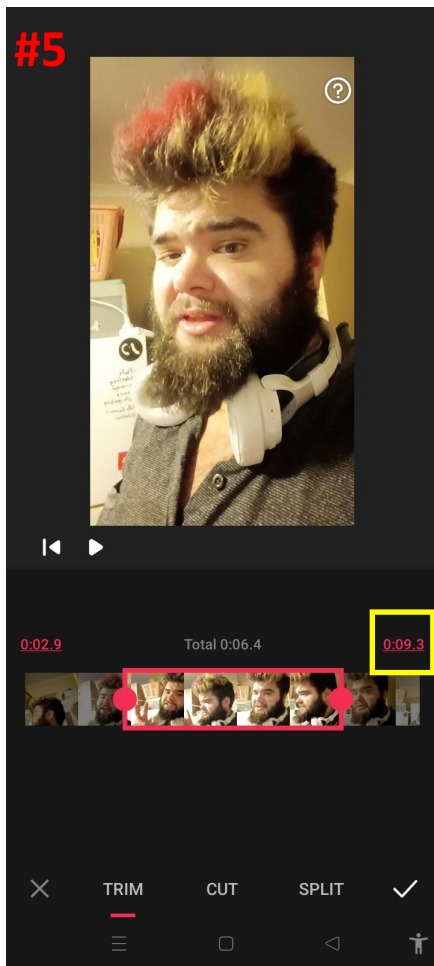


How to Edit Videos on the Go

My friend Alex has the distinct displeasure of having a good job, wife, kids, and a few hobbies. Which take away from the true meaning of life—getting famous on the internet. So, I’m going to show Alex how he can edit videos on the couch (with headphones) while his wife watches whatever trash is popular these days.

1. Download “Video Maker—Video Guru”. This is by no means the best editor, but it works and doesn’t cause drama.
2. Open the app and start a “new project”.
3. Select the videos you want to use, in the order he wants them shown, the order can be changed later.
4. Click the clip you want to work on, it will highlight and the menu will change. Use the split tool to cut the rough ends of the clip. Delete off-cuts. For a finer cut use the trim tool.





5. Figuring out the trim tool takes a full 5-minutes– mastering it takes a few months. Best to just be articulate while recording,

6. Once the videos are in order you will need to add voice overs to the silent clips (clips can be made silent from the video clip menu). Select the audio menu by tapping on the blank space.

7. Scroll to the far right to select record.

8. Press record.

9. Say your lines, go through the process get to the main menu.

10. To get to the default menu easily, click on a clip, click it again, nothing will be highlighted, congrats its the default menu.

11. Click the text tool, add your text. I recommend selecting a specific text font, size, colour for consistency and efficiency.

12. Play the whole video through once. Fix any obvious mistakes, publish, post. Perfection is the enemy of speed - is cringe is good.
